

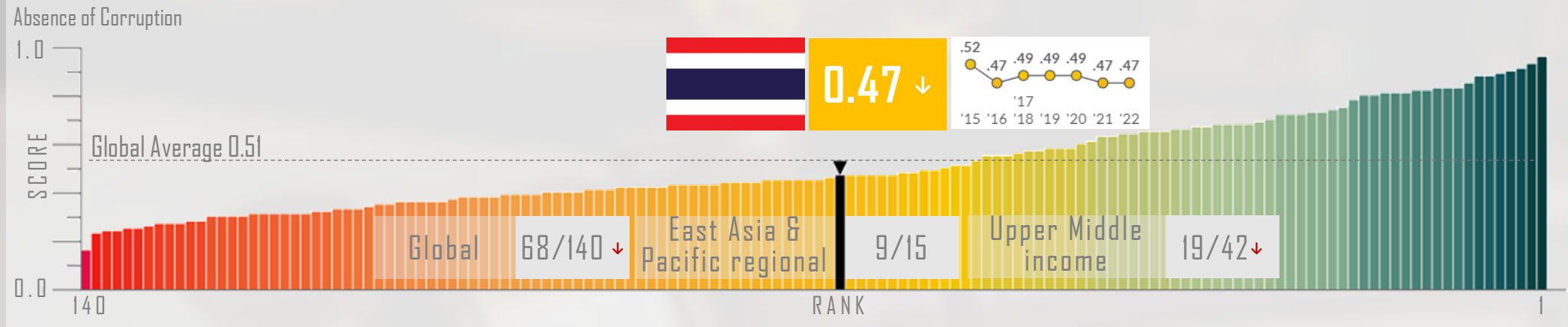

# Absence of Corruption in WJP Rule of Law Index



Priority:

Sub-Factor	Score	Global Rank	Regional Rank	Income Rank
Government officials in <b>the legislative branch</b> do not use public office for private gain	0.25 Global avg. 0.35	91	14	21
Government officials in <b>the executive branch</b> do not use public office for private gain	0.43 Global avg. 0.49	71	13	17
Government officials in <b>the police and the military</b> do not use public office for private gain	0.47 Global avg. 0.59	93	12	35
Government officials in <b>the judicial branch</b> do not use public office for private gain	0.71 Global avg. 0.61	56	8	15
